Plastic cups & containers
Plastic bottles
Milk jugs

Cardboard



CLEAN & EMPTY

Corrugated cardboard
Shipping boxes

Empty and flatten all cardboard boxes

Cardboard may be placed in cardboard or mixed paper bins.

Glass



CLEAN & EMPTY

Glass bottles & jars

Glass recycling only available at select locations, see reverse for where accepted.
